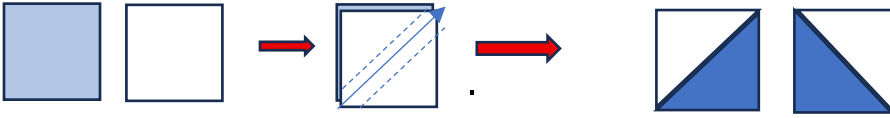


SMALL ROCKET

All of the seam allowances are 1/4"



Using the method above, make two half square triangles with the one 7" focal fabric and one background fabric. With 7" squares right sides together, draw a diagonal line on back of light fabric. Sew 1/4" on either side of line. Cut on drawn line. Press open and trim to 6-1/2"

Using two white 4-1/2" squares and four 2-1/2" squares create two sections of the bottom on rocket. Use one focal fabric 4-1/2" square and two 2-1/2" focal fabric squares for make another section of the bottom of the rocket.

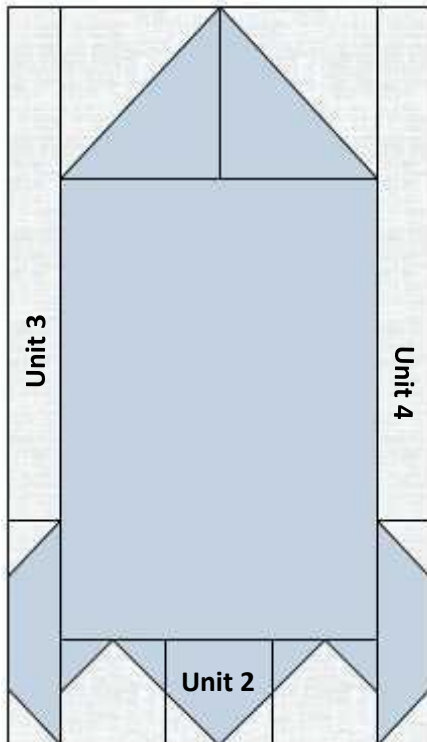


Using the 8-1/2" focal fabric rectangles and the 2-1/2" squares create the block below



Blocks for units 3 and 4.

Assembly rocket using the diagram below



Step 1: Sew two half square triangles together to create point of rocket. (Unit 2)

Step 2: Sew the point you just created to top of the 12-1/2" x 16-1/2" focal fabric rectangle.

Step 3: Sew the three bottom squares together as shown and attach to bottom of center panel.

Step 4: Sew 8-1/2" x 2-1/2" units to the 2-1/2" x 18-1/2" strips as shown to create side panels.

Step 5: Sew Units 3 and 4 to the sides of the center panel.

Complete quilt top by adding borders as desired
