## Squares and Prairie Points

Any size squares can be used for this quilt. Lay out your squares to create a pleasing effect. Sew squares together by rows; then sew rows together. A border may be added.

Prairie Points: Fold a square diagonally from corner to corner with wrong sides together. Fold again along the longest edge, making sure you align the raw edges. Press lightly to keep folds in place prior to basting them to the squares.

Suggestion: Cut 88-5 1/2" squares. Use 77 squares for quilt top (set $7 \times 11$ ) and 11 squares for prairie points. Cut border strips $3^{\prime \prime}$ wide. Finished size, approximately 40" x 60"
