

# Elephant


## Darks

Forty-nine 5" squares  
Six 6" squares  
Five 5" dark squares and four 6" squares of a consistent color for the ears  
Two 5-1/2" WOF strips ( top and bottom outer borders)

## Lights

Twenty-three 5" squares  
Six 6" squares  
Two 2-1/2" WOF strips (top and bottom inner border)

Using the method below, make 8 half square triangles with four 6" white/lights and four color 6" squares (you will only use 7). Draw line diagonally across back of light fabric. Put fabrics right sides together and sew 1/4" on either side of drawn line. Cut on solid line to create two identical half square triangles. Trim all half square triangles to 5"



Now make four half square triangles using two 6" light and two 6" dark squares for part of ear (you will only use 3).



Finally make four mixed dark and color half square triangles using **two** dark 6" squares and **two** color 6" squares (you will only use 3) Trim all half square triangles to 5"



Arrange squares and half square triangles in a pleasing manner. Sew quilt together in columns as shown below. Then sew strips together to create. Sew inner border to top and bottom. Then sew outer border to top and bottom.
