## Bricks and Blocks

Fabric:
Twelve 8-1/2" colored squares (Focal fabric) Twenty Three $4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ cx $8-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ colored bricks All of the seam allowances are $1 / 4$ "

Eight width of fabric sashing strips
Sixteen $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 8-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ sashing strip

## Block Row:

Sew one $4-1 / 2$ " $\times 8-1 / 2$ " brick to $2-1 / 2 \times 8-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ background strip. Then sew a $8-1 / 2$ " square focal fabric to this unit. Continue sewing sashing strips, $8-1 / 2$ squares and brick across, ending with a brick as shown, make 4 .


One $4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 8-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ brick $2-1 / 2 \times 8-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ background rectangle


Completed block row should measure $\approx 8-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 40-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
Make 4.

## Brick Row:

Sew 5 bricks end to end. Make 3.


## Assembly:



Completed brick row should measure $\approx 4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 40-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Make 3
