

Bricks and Blocks

Fabric:

Twelve 8-1/2" colored squares (Focal fabric)

Twenty Three 4-1/2" x 8-1/2" colored bricks

All of the seam allowances are 1/4"

Eight width of fabric sashing strips

Sixteen 2-1/2" x 8-1/2" sashing strip

Block Row:

Sew one 4-1/2" x 8-1/2" brick to 2-1/2 x 8-1/2" background strip. Then sew a 8-1/2" square focal fabric to this unit. Continue sewing sashing strips, 8-1/2 squares and brick across, ending with a brick as shown, make 4.



One 4-1/2" x 8-1/2" brick 2-1/2 x 8-1/2" background rectangle



Completed block row should measure $\approx 8\text{-}1/2"$ x $40\text{-}1/2"$
Make 4.

Brick Row:

Sew 5 bricks end to end. Make 3.



Completed brick row should measure $\approx 4\text{-}1/2"$ x $40\text{-}1/2"$
Make 3
