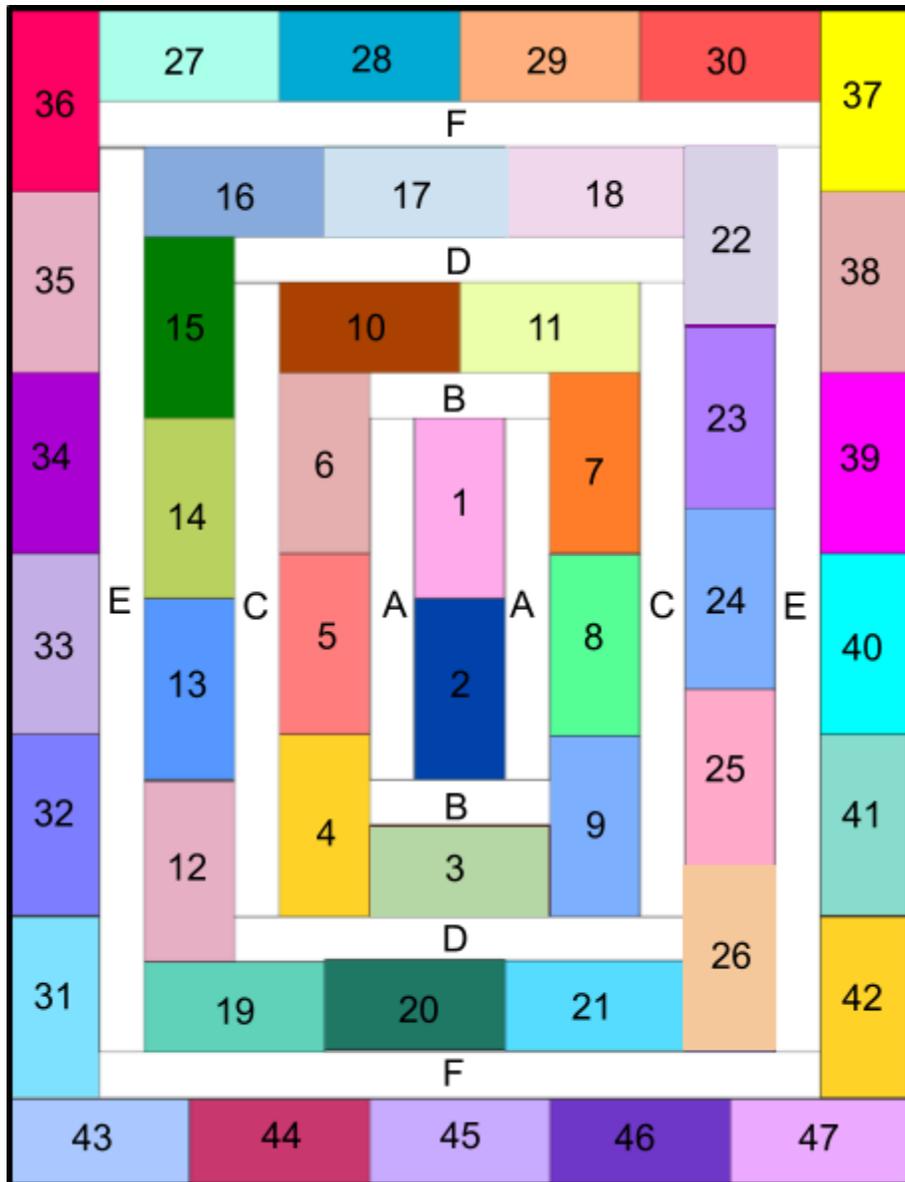


# Bricked In



Quilt made using 4.5" × 8.5" Rectangles (Bricks) and 2.5" Strips  
 Approximate Quilt size: 40" × 52"

## Materials Needed

### From Assorted Print Fabrics

- 47 - 4.5" × 8.5" rectangles (1-47)

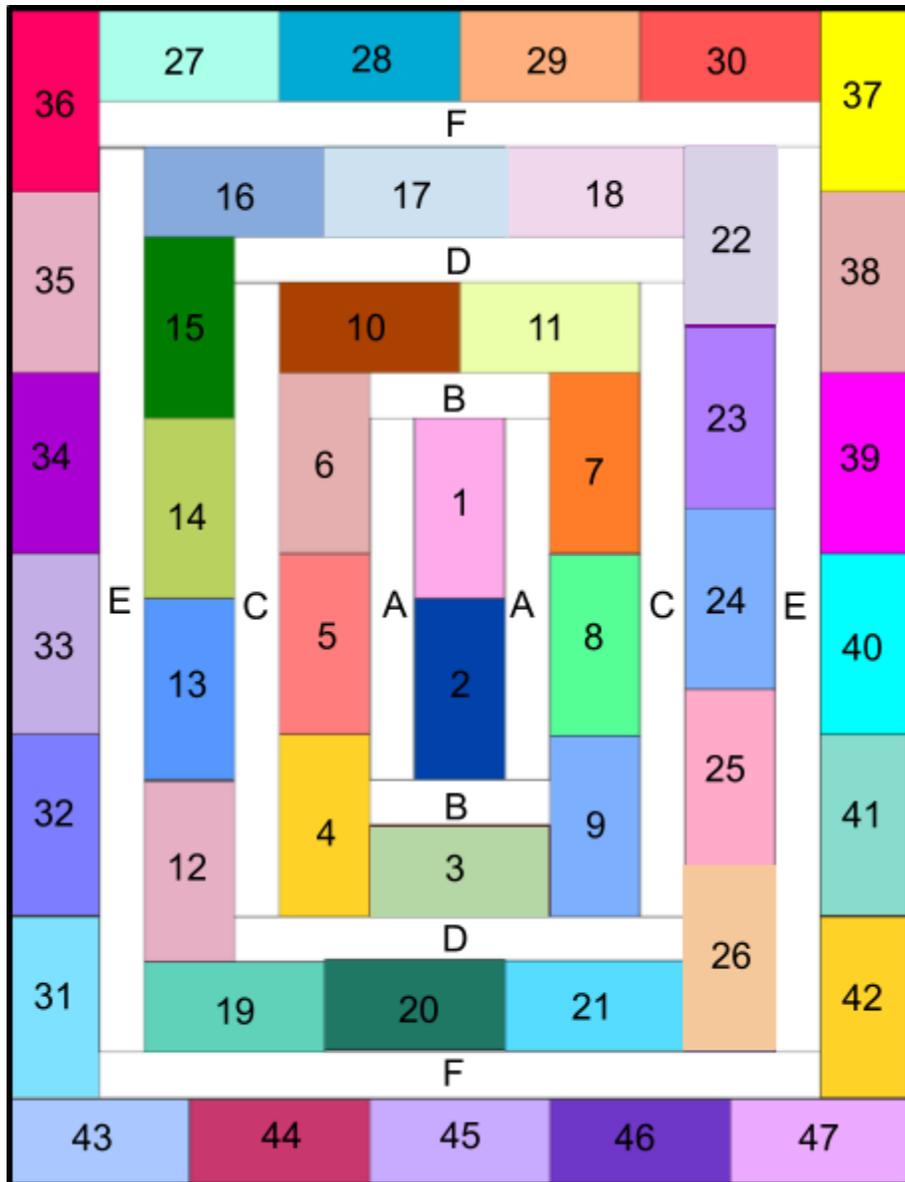
### From Background (Sashing) Fabric

- 10 - 2.5" width of fabric strips cut (after confirming length) into:
  - 2 - 2.5" × 8.5" rectangles (B)
  - 2 - 2.5" × 16.5" rectangles (A)
  - 2 - 2.5" × 20.5" rectangles (D)
  - 2 - 2.5" × 28.5" rectangles (C)
  - 2 - 2.5" × 32.5" rectangles (F)
  - 2 - 2.5" × 40.5" rectangles (E)

## Sewing Instructions

1. **Pieces 1-47.** Use the numbered guide to follow the order in which to sew the rectangles together. The rectangles should all be sewn end to end.
2. **Sashing Pieces A-F.** Add the sashing as indicated, being sure to add the side sashings first and then the top and bottom.
3. Add the sewn groups of rectangles as indicated. For example: The strip made of pieces 4-6 should be added to the left side after adding rectangle 3 to sashing piece B.

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
