SKATEBOARD QUILT

Adapted from Quiltmaker, May/June 2012.

Please see magazine for more ideas and instructions.

FOCAL FABRIC:

Cut (twelve) piece of focal fabric to 6-1/2" x 16-1/2"

To strip piece background and wheels for 12 skateboards;

BACKGROUND:

Cut **two** pieces of background fabric to 3-1/2" x WOF Cut **one** piece of background fabric to 6-1/2" x WOF


Cut three pieces of background fabric to 2-1/2" x WOF and sub-cut into forty-eight 2-1/2" squares

You will need additional background strips for sashing Image 1 below shows 2-1/2" sashing. Finished quilt with no borders will measure 38" x 52" Image 2 shows 1-1/2" sashing with 2-1/2" border and will measure 40" x 55"



Cut two pieces of black/brown fabric to 2-1/2"x WOF

Sew the background and wheel fabric together following skateboard diagram. Sub-cut these into (**twenty-four**) 1-1/2" strips



Sew the 2-1/2" squares to corners of each focal fabric rectangle (the 6-1/2" x 16-1/2" rectangle). Sew the 1-1/2" wheel sections to each side of the board as shown in the diagram. Sew block together with sashing strips.




